



2008 MCLL Team Reporter Volunteer Instructions

1. Attend your team's games and make notes on great plays by your team's players and write a brief report for your team's game report to post on the MCLL team website.
2. Post your game summary on the MCLL website as follows:
 - a. After the game, go to MCLL website (www.murpheyandler.org), click on appropriate league, then your team name to bring up your team page. Scroll ALL the way to the bottom and click on "team admin page".
 - b. On Game report box, scroll through and pick date/time of game that you will be reporting about. Enter your report in the summary section and click on submit.
 - c. Go back to team page, click on game reports to view what you have entered to be sure it appears the way you want it to. Edit if necessary following steps a-c.

Helpful hints:

- Ask your team coach for the password for your team admin page if you do not have it.
- You may want to type report in advance using a text editor then cut and paste.
- Game dates are year – month – day eg, March 17th game would show as: 2008-03-17.
- Keep your game result brief, as you are limited to amount of text you may enter.
- Here's a sample game report for the Major Astros to give you an idea of what to write.

Cubs 4 - Astros 6. Astros won a nail biter with some great hitting, aggressive baserunning by Johnathan Langley, and a great defensive play by Jordan Fuller from third base to first. Chandler Follis was our closer shutting down their hitters.
