

BAT Requirements

(Updated: January 2024)

Starting January 1, 2018, a new bat standard (USABat) was introduced and utilized by several organizations, including Dizzy Dean. For 2024 (Spring & Fall), Murphey Candler Baseball (MCB) has amended their bat rules for player safety. For Rookie, Southern, International, Coastal, and AA, all bats must be 2 5/8" and have the USABat stamp. For Upper Leagues AAA and Major, bats can be 2 5/8" with USABat stamp or 2 ½" with 1.15bpf certification stamp.





What is not allowed?

For all leagues, Bats that have a 2 5/8" or 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " barrel and 1.15bpf stamp will not be allowed. For Rookie, Southern, International, Coastal, and AA, 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " with 1.15bpf stamp will not be allowed.

If there are any questions, please reach out to your League Director. MCB will continue to monitor both the evolution of the new USABat bats and Dizzy Dean regulations, as well as future bat requirements, as needed.
